As the 2009-2010 basketball season ends I wanted to take time to write you a note giving you some information on our 2010 Summer Presbyterian College Team Overnight Camp Sponsorship, along with information on this year's 2009-2010 Mid-Carolina Varsity Boys' Basketball Season.

Sponsorship Information:

Each Summer for the past four year's I've taken our MCHS Junior Varsity & Varsity Boys' Basketball Teams to the Presbyterian College summer four day overnight team camp in June of each year. This camp includes three all you can eat meals each day in the Presbyterian College dining hall, three nights boarding in one of Presbyterian College's dormitory buildings, three official eight minute four quarter games each day, against varsity teams from South Carolina, North Carolina, Georgia, and Florida from all classification levels.

This camp has been an excellent tool for our basketball program each of the past four years. Our MCHS Boys' Basketball Teams have had the opportunity to play against teams we do not normally play against during the regular season & the camp gives our MCHS Boys' Basketball Players a chance to experience life on a college campus. This camp helps boost team morale and team unity.

The cost of the Presbyterian College team camp is \$220.00 per player. I have been forced to pay over \$3,000.00 dollars each year out of our Mid-Carolina High School Boys' Basketball Fund-Raising Account, because many of our MCHS Junior Varsity and Varsity Players cannot afford the cost of this camp. 2009-2010 MCHS BBT Season Recap:

We ended our season with a first round Class AA state playoff loss to Eau Claire High School in Columbia, SC on Feb. 17th, 2010. Our MCHS BBT finished with a 12-10 record and finished our region schedule in a region runner-up tie breaker with Strom Thurmond High School at 6-4. We lost our last regular season game to Newberry High School, the 09-10 Region III-AA Champs 51-50 in front of 1,600 people in our gym in Prosperity, SC. Our Varsity Boys stormed back after being down 10 points and took the lead with one minute to go, before Hubert Wicker, my senior point guard threw the ball away with 11 seconds to go down 1 and put us in a hole. Had we won that game we would have finished as the Region III-AA Runner-up and hosted the 1st Round State Playoff game vs. Columbia High School at MCHS. Instead, we were forced to play a Region III-AA Tie-breaker game vs. Strom Thurmond High School. We lost our region Tie-breaker game 53-50 to put us in 3rd place in our region entering the state playoffs.

Team Highlights: MCHS Varsity Boys Basketball Team Won the 2009 Mid-Carolina High School Pre-Xmas Tournament by defeating Tasmania NITCP, the Australian All-Star Team visiting the Carolina's by 14 points in the Championship Game on Dec. 19th, 2009. Junior Guard, CJ Edwards was named tournament MVP after scoring 18 points in the championship game. Senior forwards, Krishawn Holley & Calvin Herbert were also named to the MCHS Christmas Tournament All-Tournament Team after avg. double figure points and rebounds over the course of the tournament games. Our Varsity Boys' Basketball Team enjoyed a 9 game home winning streak at MCHS before losing to Newberry High School by one point on Feb. 11th, 2010 in our last regular season game of the season.

Individual Player Highlights: Calvin Herbert, 6'1 Senior Forward/Post broke Raley Downings 1970 record of 720 rebounds by ended his career with 768 rebounds. Calvin also broke the MCHS single game rebound record with 24 rebounds vs. Union County High School in December of 2009. Calvin was also named to the Class AA Top five seniors in the state of South Carolina in Class AA Basketball by the South Carolina Basketball Coaches Association in November of 2009. Krishawn Holley, 6'2 Senior Forward was named All Region III-AA for the second consecutive year after avg. 11 ppg, 10 rpg, and 1.5 steals. Calvin Herbert, 6'1 Senior Forward was named All-Region III-AA for the third consecutive year after avg. 13 ppg, 11 rpg, and 1.7 steals.

Looking Ahead To The 2010-2011 Season:

We have a good group of kids returning next season. Our Varsity Boys' Basketball Team has nine varsity returners coming back to play for the 2010-2011 season. 6'3 wing-Junior Wing CJ Edwards will return for his season season next year. CJ Avg. 10ppg, 4 rpg, 3 steals, and .5 blocks per game as a junior. CJ was 2nd on the team in three pointers with 27. Mac Lake, 6'2 Junior Forward will return for his season season next year. Mac avg. 8 ppg, 3 rpg, 2 assists, 1.5 steals this season and hit 78% of his foul shots. We also return 5'6 sophomore guard Jacobi Boyd and 6'1 sophomore post player Jared Parnell. Jacobi avg. 6 ppg, 1 steal, 1 assist as a sophomore. Jacobi hit 28 threes as a sophomore and scored in double figures 6 times this season. Jared Parnell averaged 2 ppg and 1 rebound playing behind All-Region Senior Post Players Calvin Herbert & Krishawn Holley.

Personal Note:

On a personal note, my wife is expecting my son, Zarek Lee Reid at anytime. My daughter, Zoe recently turned 2 years old in December, 2009. Zoe acts like her dad and looks like her mom, needless to say life at the Reid house will never be the same.
